The KNN Faculty Scholars program is designed to nurture emerging leaders who seek to embody lifelong learning, whole-person growth and human-centered innovation — advocating for the needs of patients, clinicians, educators, trainees and learners. This fellowship offers experiential learning, educational project work, scholarship and personal and professional development through the rich curriculum from the Harvard Macy Institute Program for Educators in Health Professions, complemented by mentorship, guidance and expertise from the KNN. The fellowship encourages participants to explore themes such as Educational Theory & Practice, Curriculum Design, and Leadership & Change Management through the lens of human flourishing.

Faculty scholars will have opportunities to integrate the elements of character, caring and practical wisdom toward flourishing into their educational projects. The KNN will provide ongoing support and opportunities to engage with national efforts, including national meetings, virtual seminars and communities of practice.
